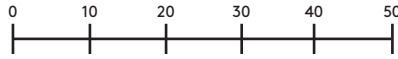

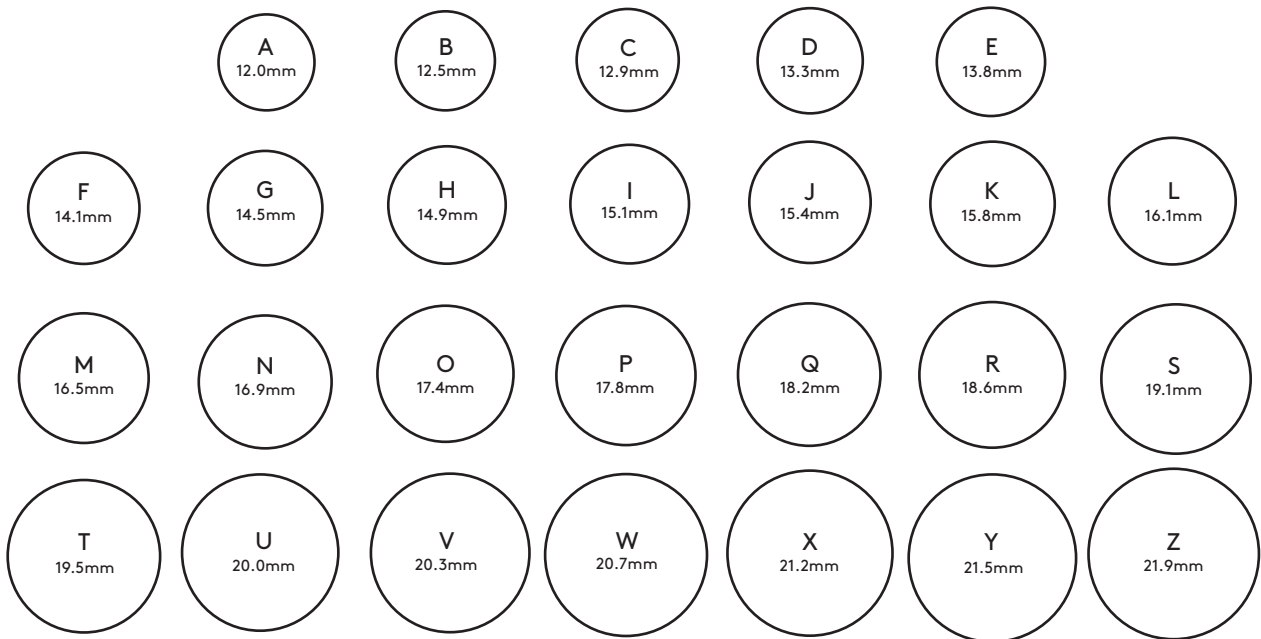

MEASURE A RING

Using an existing ring that fits the finger you are sizing for, place it on the ring outlines below to determine the correct size.

The right size will be when the edge of the circle touches the inside of your ring all the way around.



MEASURE A FINGER

Cut around the sizer below and make slit where indicated, make a loose circle by threading the end through the slit, then place on the finger being measured and tighten, the sizer should sit comfortably around your finger, adjust if need be.

Make sure you can remove the sizer over the knuckle, the letter indicated by 'your size' in the slit indicates the ring size needed for the finger. Be careful not to pull too tight as this will give an inaccurate size, make sure hands are warm as cold fingers are slimmer.
